Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southeastern areas mostly dry this morning, but heavy rain in southwest Britain will spread northeast across the country. Elsewhere, there will be scattered showers. Overnight there will be heavy showers and clear intervals for many, with longer periods of rain across some central areas. Becoming windy in the far south.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Torrential slow-moving showers or thunderstorms across England and Wales on Saturday, with longer periods of rain for northern England and later southwest England. Becoming drier further northwest. Windy on southern coasts. Most places becoming dry with sunny spells on Sunday with any showers in the east at first, dying away.
