Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1800 UTC Monday 05 October to 1800 UTC Tuesday 06 October 2020

#### General Situation

An area of low pressure centred in the central North Sea will drift slowly northwards over the next day or two, bringing unsettled weather to all areas, with gales in some southern and western waters.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time near Orkney.

Showers, occasionally thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming west 4 to 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later except in Moray Firth, occasionally very rough later in north.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming west, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight in south.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly, mainly 4 at first in north, otherwise 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers in north.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers at first.  
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, veering westerly later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in south, decreasing 4 at times in north.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain then showers, perhaps thundery later.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers, perhaps thundery.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly 7 or gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6, then backing southwesterly 3 to 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Thundery showers at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers, perhaps thundery later.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 5 or 6, then backing southwest 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers at first, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, veering west 6 to gale 8.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter, becoming rough or very rough west of Lizard Point.  
Occasional rain then showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West 6 to gale 8, veering northwest, then becoming cyclonic later 4 to 6.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in far southwest, becoming slight or moderate east of the Lizard.  
Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 5 or 6, then becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough, then slight or moderate later north and east of lundy.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, veering northwest later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in south.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, backing southwest 4 or 5, then veering northwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate at first in north, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight until later in north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 to 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 to 7.

Mostly moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering northwest 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight until later in east, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in north.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north, occasionally very rough at first in far northwest.  
Occasional rain then showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less at first in Firth of Clyde, otherwise northwesterly, backing westerly for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel.  
Smooth or slight in Firth of Clyde, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near Mull of Kintyre.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times in Firth of Clyde.  
Slight or moderate throughout in sheltered north, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain then showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less at first in east, otherwise westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far south, increasing 6 or 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 at first, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time.  
Occasional rain then showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming westerly 5 to 7 later in south.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far south.  
Occasional rain at first in south, otherwise showers, thundery at times in north.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time.  
Smooth or slight at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time to the south of skye.  
Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming westerly 5 to 7 later in south.

Moderate, occasionally slight in north, becoming moderate or rough later in south.

Occasional rain at first in south, otherwise showers, thundery at times in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate at first in north, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 05 Oct 2020 at 1800 UTC until Tuesday 06 Oct 2020 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure over Scotland edges north through Monday night bringing a fresh to strong easterly or southeasterly airstream across Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Southeasterly backing easterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later

Moderate or rough

Showers

Good, occasionally poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 06 Oct until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 06 Oct:

East 5 to 7 backing northeast 3 or 4

Moderate or rough

Showers

Good, occasionally poor

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 5 to 6, occasionally 7, then from around midnight west 6 to 7, occasionally gale 8 from around dawn.

Rough, decreasing rather rough in the south and east of the area for a time this evening and early tonight, becoming occasionally very rough in the west by afternoon.

Blustery showers, locally heavy, perhaps prolonged at times this evening.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 6 to 7, occasionally gale 8, veering northwest 5 to 7 around midnight, decreasing 4 to 5 by dawn, backing west to southwest in the morning and southwest to south in the afternoon.

Rough, occasionally very rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough with a low swell later Wednesday morning.

Isolated showers, then occasional rain from Wednesday afternoon, becoming persistent and heavier later.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.
