Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Outbreaks of rain across northern England and Wales will last for much of the day, edging into southern Scotland for a time, and also across southwest England. Some of the rain will be heavy and will bring the risk of local flooding. Northern and western Scotland and much of Northern Ireland will have some sunshine, but also scattered showers. Central and eastern England should remain dry, bright and quite mild.

Tonight, organised rain across England will clear away eastwards, then most places will become dry, clear and quite chilly.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A sunny start for Wednesday, otherwise it will remain unsettled and windy with rain at times.
