Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Largely cloudy and breezy to start with rain across parts of the northwest and some southern counties. The rain should generally ease with bright or sunny intervals developing, although showers may continue, mainly across the northwest. Overnight, a band of rain, heavy at times, will push southeastwards to affect many northern areas by dawn. Largely dry but cloudy elsewhere.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A band of heavy rain will push southeastwards across much of the country on Friday with clearer but showery conditions following. The rain will clear on Saturday to leave sunshine and showers, mainly in the west. Breezy and feeling rather cold.
