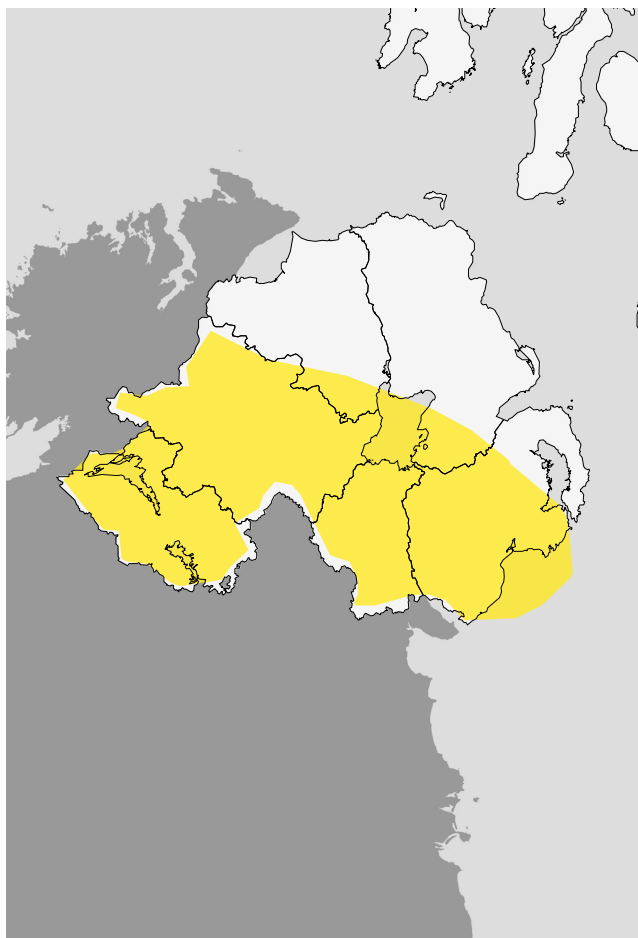

## Snow expected to fall across the southern half of Northern Ireland Saturday night

### What to expect

- Some roads and railways likely to be affected with longer journey times by road, bus and train services

### Further details

An area of snow is expected to cross the southern half of Northern Ireland on Saturday night, easing and clearing during the early hours of Sunday morning

Accumulations of 1-3 cm are likely in places with spots of 5 cm possible., mainly for higher ground.
