Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Eastern areas will start bright, but thickening cloud will bring organised rain eastwards to all areas during the day. Some of this will be heavy and prolonged, especially across western hills where it will be very misty. It will become rather windy, especially near coasts in the west and south.

Tonight, southern and southeastern areas will remain cloudy with rain, but elsewhere it will turn clearer, but still with blustery showers.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain across southeastern England will clear, then Friday will have sunshine and squally showers blown through on northwesterly gales. Saturday will be quieter and mostly dry with some sunshine, but further rain will reach the northwest later.
