Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A cold start for many, with patchy frost and ice in places. It will often be cloudy throughout the day, with outbreaks of light rain, sleet and snow for some. However, the snow will be confined largely to the hills. There will also be some bright or sunny spells developing at times too.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Remaining cold throughout the weekend. It will be mainly cloudy on Saturday with a little light rain and hill snow developing at times. Turning windier on Sunday, with persistent rain slowly pushing east across most areas through the day, this then turning to snow for many later.
