Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a cold and cloudy day for much of the UK, with an overnight frost in places. However, outbreaks of rain, sleet and in places, snow across southwestern parts, will spread east through the day. Also, outbreaks of rain and hill snow will spread slowly across northern areas, accompanied by brisk southwesterly winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will remain rather unsettled and cold, with outbreaks of rain, sleet and hill snow for many parts of the UK, accompanied by brisk southwesterly winds. However, the far south of England may stay dry and could possibly see some bright or sunny spells.
