Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Dry in England and Wales with sunshine in places. Cloud and wind increasing over Scotland and Northern Ireland, with rain reaching the west in afternoon, moving to Wales and the north and southeast of England by morning. Clearer skies following, though with showers in the north. Becoming misty overnight in central and southeast England.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On Tuesday, Scotland and Northern Ireland fine and quite sunny. Rain at first in England and Wales, clearing away southeastwards. Frost forming by late afternoon. Widespread frost and patchy fog on Wednesday, persisting over parts of England and Wales. Strengthening winds across Scotland and Northern Ireland.
