

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Snow across Wales, central and southern England will continue northwards, with significant accumulations leading to disruption. Showers following to southern Britain, mainly to western areas. Wintry showers persisting eastern and northern Scotland. Tonight sleet and snow clearing Northern Ireland. Across England light snow will become limited to northern areas, while freezing fog patches develop further south. Snow showers continuing eastern Scotland.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday outbreaks of sleet or snow across northern England and Scotland dying away. Occasional rain southern England, showers across N.Ireland. Otherwise largely dry, often dull and cloudy. Saturday rain or showers, with snow in places across northern Britain.
