Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain with snow over the hills across Central Scotland and Northern Ireland extending to Northern Scotland. England, Wales and Southern Scotland will see some sunshine but also heavy showers with hail and thunder in places. Tonight rain with snow over hills continuing over Scotland. Rain also affecting southeast England. Elsewhere becoming dry and cold.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Central and western areas will be mostly dry on Sunday with sunny spells. Eastern areas seeing a few showers. During Monday heavy rain and gales will affect the northwest. Elsewhere a little rain in the morning, becoming dry and bright by the afternoon but breezy.
