Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A grey, misty start for many, and parts of northern and western Scotland will remain dull and damp throughout the day. Elsewhere, many places will brighten with some sunny spells developing and it should feel pleasantly warm in just light winds. Rain will spread to much of Scotland overnight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Some warm sunny spells can be expected again in the south on Friday but a band of thicker cloud and rain in the far north will spread slowly southwards through the day. On Saturday much colder, windier weather with sunshine and wintry showers will spread to all parts.
