Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Showery outbreaks of rain in eastern England will clear this morning, otherwise showers, locally heavy and thundery, are expected to become widespread again, however, some parts could stay dry. It'll be windy in the south and generally feel rather cool. Tonight cloud and showery rain will affect Northern Ireland, Scotland and later on northern England and Wales, but many other parts will become dry with clear intervals, although showers will continue to affect parts of the southwest and the Channel coastline.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Showers will continue over the weekend, some heavy. More persistent showery rain may spread into southern England on Sunday.
