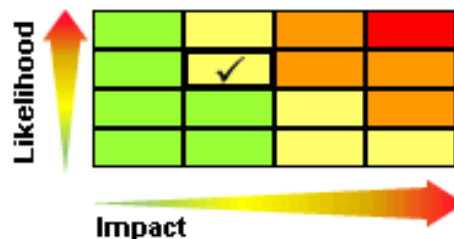

Another period of strong, moist southwesterly winds will bring another spell of wet weather to Northern Ireland on Monday night and early Tuesday morning. Rainfall totals of 20 to 30 mm are likely within the warning area, which given the pre-existing saturation, may well lead to some flooding impacts.

Valid from 00:05 on Tue, 22nd Dec 2015 until 09:00 on Tue, 22nd Dec 2015

Outbreaks of rain arriving late on Monday evening will become heavy at times overnight, before clearing by daybreak on Tuesday. With lough and river levels still very high, some renewed flooding is likely in places, while surface water and spray will bring generally difficult driving conditions. Please be aware of the risk of some low level travel disruption.
