

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Thursday 01 Dec 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain will spread across Northern Ireland and Scotland, accompanied by brisk southwesterly winds. Elsewhere it will be rather chilly start, with a widespread frost initially as well as some icy patches, but it should be fine and dry thereafter, although with an increasing southwesterly wind. However, rain will reach Wales and parts of western England by evening.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will be a rather unsettled and windy weekend, with outbreaks of rain in the south initially, followed by more general sunshine and showers. These showers are likely to turn to snow over some northern high ground, especially across Scotland.
