Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy throughout, with outbreaks of mostly light rain or drizzle spreading eastwards to affect some parts, mainly western hills and coasts. There will be hill fog in the west too, but after a cold start in the north, it will become mild everywhere. Winds strengthening, with heavy rain and gales spreading from the west overnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain in the southeast at first on Wednesday will soon clear as sunshine and blustery showers follow from the west. Thursday sees thick cloud, heavy rain and gales spreading across all parts from the west, with showers following to the north later.
