Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Wednesday 01 June to 0600 UTC Thursday 02 June 2022

#### General Situation

Wednesday sees light winds across the inshore waters with showers affecting many coastlines at times, showers will dissipate into Wednesday evening as high pressure builds across the United Kingdom.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, then northwesterly 3 to 5 for a time in north.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near Orkney.
