Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Early rain soon clearing Shetland. Elsewhere a fairly cloudy start with occasional outbreaks of light rain, however it will brighten up during the day. Showers will develop across much of eastern and central England, where the odd heavy one is possible. Scotland, Northern Ireland, as well southwest England, and later Wales, will see some warm afternoon sunshine.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Much of the UK will be dry on Sunday, however outbreaks of rain will affect western parts of Northern Ireland and western Scotland later. This will move eastwards, to affect many other western areas on Monday. Southeastern England remaining dry and quite warm.
