

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Early rain, locally heavy, over southeast England should soon clear. Otherwise a rather cloudy day with occasional sunny spells and isolated showers is expected, although more frequent, locally heavy, showers are likely across eastern England in the morning, and isolated heavy ones are possible over southern parts during the afternoon. Temperatures will be just below normal generally.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A mixture of sunny spells and scattered showers is expected on both Friday and Saturday, with those showers more frequent on Saturday. Northern and eastern parts will see the most frequent, blustery and perhaps heavy outbreaks. Temperatures generally near or just below normal.
