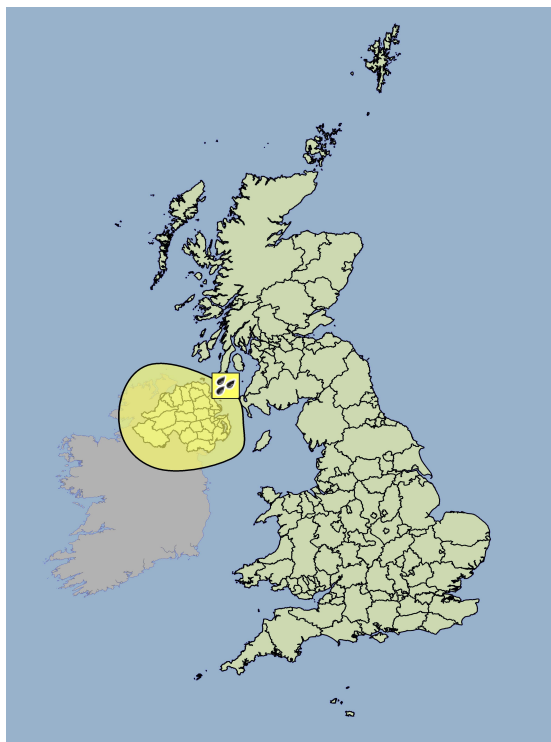




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A frontal system could bring some places around 20-30 mm within about 6 hours overnight into early Wednesday, leading to some surface water flooding. This is perhaps more likely where heavy showers have fallen earlier on Tuesday or preceding days, leading to pre-existing wet conditions.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **22:00 on Tue, 05th Aug 2014** until **07:00 on Wed, 06th Aug 2014**

Outbreaks of occasionally heavy rain will cross Northern Ireland overnight, clearing early on Wednesday morning.

The public should be aware of the potential for localised minor disruption due to surface water flooding.
