Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A chilly start with some sunny spells today. Broken cloud will bring scattered showers, locally heavy, through the day, with more prolonged rain across northeast Scotland. Feeling rather cool with light to moderate winds. Any daytime showers should soon die away this evening with some late sunny spells. Largely dry and chilly with clear spells and light winds overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Remaining rather cool with light winds and a mixture of sunshine and scattered showers, locally heavy, especially across parts of England on Sunday and Monday. Largely dry with sunny spells in the evenings with plenty of clear, chilly conditions overnight.
