

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally cloudy with outbreaks of rain in Scotland and Northern Ireland, though becoming dry with clear spells overnight. Many other places starting dry but showers will develop widely during the day. These are likely to be heavy and thundery at times, particularly over Wales and central and southern England, where they will continue for much of the night.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Rain persisting in southeast England until tomorrow afternoon. Elsewhere, often cloudy with some sunny spells, but light rain is expected across northern parts. Monday should be dry and bright with the odd shower. A cold bank holiday, though, with brisk northeasterly winds.
