

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Showery outbreaks of rain spreading erratically northwards across England and Wales, reaching Northern Ireland later. Eastern Scotland and northeastern England remaining cloudy with patchy fog, this creeping southwards along eastern coasts. Elsewhere, mainly dry with some mist patches.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Locally heavy showery rain across western parts will slowly progress northeastwards on Thursday. Some drier and possibly brighter spells ahead of the rain. On Friday, rain will slowly clear from northeast parts of the UK. Elsewhere, a cloudy start but brighter spells developing and perhaps a few showers. Feeling cooler than of late, but still warm in any sunshine.
