

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 02 Oct 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Beginning dry and bright for most but showers will soon spread into the west, becoming heavy and persistent across the northwest thereafter. An organised band of persistent, heavy rain will push into the south during the afternoon to affect all but Scotland during the night. This rain will clear by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Rain will spread across much of England and southeastern Wales during Sunday, with a few showers elsewhere, becoming drier later in the west. Monday will be drier and brighter at first, but rain will spread from the west in the evening. Windy throughout, with temperatures near normal.
