Headline:

Heavy rain in the north, sunshine and thundery showers elsewhere.

Today:

Northern Scotland starting dry, but cloudy with rain spreading steadily north, some heavy, possibly thundery. Sunny intervals and scattered heavy, thundery showers elsewhere, some of them slow moving, bringing a risk of local flooding.

Tonight:

Rain across Scotland becoming confined to the far north. Elsewhere, heavy showers slowly dying back to western and southern coasts.

Outlook for Tuesday:

Sunny periods and heavy, thundery showers.
