Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mist or fog patches should slowly clear through the morning with sunny spells developing. There may be some outbreaks of rain at first in the northwest. Southeast England will become cloudy in the afternoon, with cloud spreading across the UK overnight, giving some light drizzle. Heavier rain will move across western parts of the UK later in the night.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Outbreaks of rain in the west will move eastwards, clearing during the afternoon to leave clearer conditions with blustery showers. Rain on Sunday may be heavy in the south at times with a risk of sleet or snow in the north later.
