

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 27 Jul 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places will be dry today and although it will be fairly cloudy, some sunny breaks are expected, the best of these in the north and west. However, rain will spread to Northern Ireland and northwest Scotland during the afternoon, and then across the remainder of Scotland and into western Wales overnight, with outbreaks of light rain reaching Cornwall too.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain will continue southeastwards, clearing Scotland and fragmenting across the rest of Wales and northern England on Thursday, ending up as a few outbreaks of rain in southern Britain on Friday. Otherwise it will be largely dry with some sunshine.
