

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across much of England and parts of Wales will clear eastwards, possibly taking until evening in southeast England. A mix of sunshine and showers will then spread from the north and west. Overnight, showers will continue across central parts and it will remain cloudy across the southeast of England, but otherwise it will be a dry and chilly night.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

A largely fine day on Sunday, although showers will continue for a time across parts of England and Wales, and will also develop across northwest Scotland. Monday will also be largely fine, although some western parts will become increasingly cloudy.
