REMARKS.

Winds have veered towards the N.W. on our west coasts, but have continued at West in the south of England.

Rain has fallen at some stations, and fog is still prevalent in the English Channel.

The temperatures have diminished generally, and the wind which is now northerly at several stations blew strongly from the N.W. on the northern coasts.

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REMARKS.

Since Saturday the pressure in Scotland has decreased steadily, but at the southern stations the increase reported on that day was continued yesterday: this morning the fall is general, and very considerable over the North Sea. The maximum pressure exists in the Southwest.

Temperatures have risen in the north, but have fallen at the southern stations. On the French coast they are low—more than 10° lower than in Ireland.

Winds are now moderate from the westward, but blew yesterday on the northwest coast fresh from SW and NW.

The weather has been generally fine and dry since Saturday: it is now overcast with fog in places.
