Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most areas will have a cold start with ice and fog in places. Snow falling in southeastern England will clear this morning, with eastern areas remaining dry today. Cloud and outbreaks of rain will spread into the west though, these becoming more widespread overnight. It will be cold and frosty in central and eastern but less cold elsewhere.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Monday will be mostly cloudy with outbreaks of light rain for many. By Tuesday, eastern parts will be largely dry and bright but western parts stay cloudier with further rain. It will remain very cold in the east, but less cold elsewhere.
