

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 01 May 2016

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain with strengthening winds in the northwest will move slowly south-eastwards, fragmenting and becoming patchier with time. Meanwhile, much of the south and east will see very little rain, with the southeast staying dry, with some bright or sunny spells. Overnight will be cloudy and mild, with patchy light rain and drizzle. Heavy rain in the northwest, with gales.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain and strong winds will spread south-eastwards on Monday, although not clearing the far south-east until the evening. Cooler with blustery showers in the northwest. Tuesday will see a mixture of sunshine and showers, heavy at times, especially in the north.
