Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places will start grey and misty , but this cloud should gradually thin and break, then there will be some warm sunny spells for most. However, thickening cloud will bring some rain to western Scotland later this afternoon. During this evening and overnight, rain will spread to northern and western areas, southeastern areas will remain dry and quiet.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

On Sunday, loud and patchy rain or drizzle will edge southeastwards across England and Wales, followed by sunshine and showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland. Rain will spread eastwards Sunday night, then Monday will be windy with sunshine and showers.
