Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Any early rain quickly clearing southeast England, then sunny spells and showers for much of the UK. Showers will be heaviest and most frequent across Northern Ireland, northern England and Scotland, where a risk of thunder also. However some parts of southern England may stay dry all day. Breezy, but becoming warm in southeast England.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Scattered showers for many places on Sunday, with Scotland seeing the heaviest and most frequent showers. Further outbreaks of rain or showers on Monday, although southern England may again remain dry all day. Feeling reasonably warm in the sunshine, but cooler in wetter areas.
