

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 02 Oct 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Winds strengthening across Scotland and Northern Ireland through today, with severe gales developing in the far northwest. Dry for most with sunny spells, especially across northern and central areas. The odd shower in the south. A wet and windy night across Northern Ireland and Scotland as a band of occasionally heavy rain edges southeastwards. Elsewhere dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Persistent and sometimes heavy rain affecting Northern Ireland, and southern and eastern Scotland on Friday, and perhaps moving into northern England later. Largely dry and breezy elsewhere. The rain and strong winds continuing southeastwards into Saturday, clearing the far southeast later.
