Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Frost and patchy fog will clear, then most places will be dry and sunny today, just a little patchy cloud for northern Scotland and the far southwest of England. It will feel pleasant out of doors in just light and variable winds. Tonight will be clear with a widespread sharp frost.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Most places will be dry on both days with plenty of sunshine and nights will be clear and very frosty. However, scattered wintry showers are likely in the northeast later on Sunday and on Monday, with a few affecting western coasts too.
