Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Blustery showers will affect northwestern parts of the UK, falling as snow over the high ground but also to lower levels of Scotland later. Elsewhere will see sunny spells developing after a damp start. Perhaps some rain continuing across southern England. Windy for most, with gales across the north. Staying similar overnight, with frost developing in places where skies clear.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Remaining rather cold across northern parts of the UK with further showers. These often heavy with snow over the hills and down to lower levels across Scotland at times. Elsewhere will see sunny spells, with some rain in the south.
