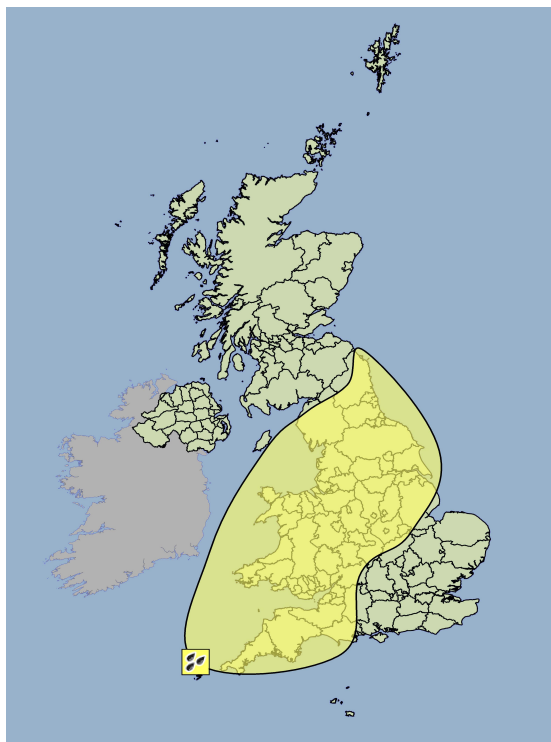




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Areas of heavy rain will spread northwards across England and Wales during Friday morning. These areas will become slow-moving, bringing prolonged and occasionally intense rain to parts of northern England, the north Midlands and north Wales later. This may cause some flooding from surface water or rivers, though there is still uncertainty as to areas most at risk. Elsewhere, heavy showers will affect the rest of England and Wales, perhaps causing some localised flooding in other parts of Wales and south west England. Friday's wet weather will continue into Saturday.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **06:00 on Fri, 06th Sep 2013** until **23:59 on Fri, 06th Sep 2013**

Heavy rain, persistent in places, will affect many areas during Friday. The public should be aware of the risk of disruption due to localised flooding.
