

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 04 Jul 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and hill fog will affect western areas at first with heavy outbreaks in the north. This rainband will push southeastwards but will weaken, giving warm sunny spells for many and only isolated showers, although it will be breezy. Showery rain will, however, continue across western Scotland, lasting into the night. Mainly dry overnight elsewhere with isolated fog patches.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

North western areas are at risk of seeing more cloud with rain at times and more of a breeze. Elsewhere, it will be fine and dry, with prolonged sunny spells and light winds. It will turn very warm across most parts.
