Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, Northern Ireland and Northern England will be cloudy and quite breezy with outbreaks of rain or drizzle. The rest of England and Wales, although starting dull and damp, should slowly improve during the morning with some pleasant afternoon sunshine. Western parts will see further rain or drizzle overnight and mild everywhere.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Further rain at times for northern parts on Wednesday but elsewhere it will probably start cloudy with some morning drizzle but should brighten up during the day with some afternoon sunshine. Overnight rain will clear the southeast to leave a day of sunshine and scattered showers for Thursday.
