Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Spells of rain or heavy, thundery showers over Northern Ireland, southern Scotland and northern England. Elsewhere sunny spells and scattered heavy showers. Rain, sleet and hill snow across northern Scotland and northeast England overnight, elsewhere showers dying out.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday, rain and sleet across eastern Scotland and northeast England, snow on Scottish mountains. Frequent snow showers over northern Scotland bringing snow accumulations, especially over hills. Elsewhere, mostly dry and sunny. On Tuesday, scattered wintry showers over eastern Britain, mainly dry with good sunny spells in the west. Temperatures ranging from cold in the north to near normal in the south.
