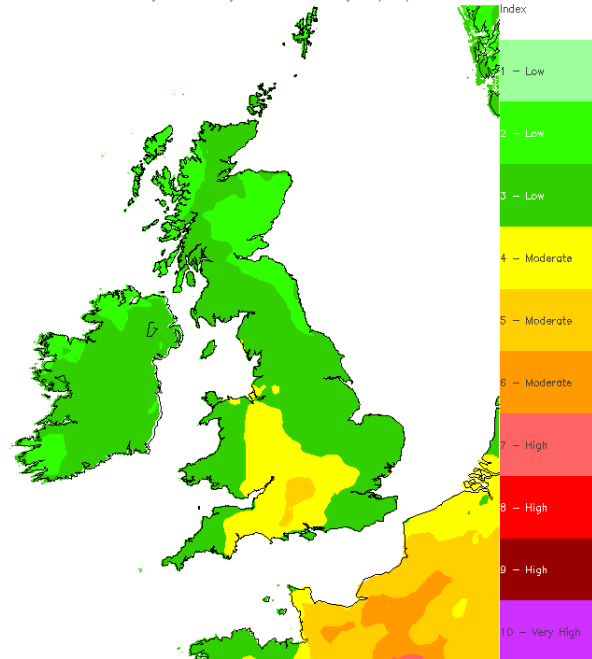

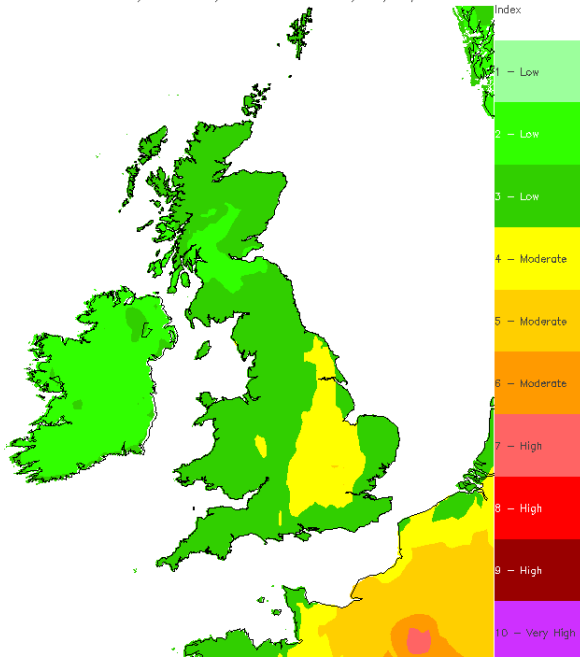

Air Quality Forecast for the UK

Issued by the Met Office

Today: Widespread areas of Moderate air pollution are expected for much of Britain, but especially the south and east in fine, settled and very hot conditions as air from continental Europe bolsters local sources of pollution. Low air pollution levels are expected for the far northwest of Britain and much of Northern Ireland.

Tomorrow: Air sourced from the Atlantic will make inroads from the west, meaning larger swathes of Low air pollution levels. Parts of Wales and eastern England may retain Moderate pollution levels.

Outlook: Air pollution levels will be mainly Low in this period in more changeable and seasonable weather conditions, although areas of Moderate remain possible in places, mainly in southern Britain.
