Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a chilly start across Scotland with some patchy frost and fog, but here we will see some warm sunshine especially in the west. Elsewhere, it will be mostly cloudy with the odd spot of rain, but across southwest England the rain will be heavier and more persistent.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunday and Monday will be mainly dry with the best of the sunshine likely across the west, where it will be warm at times. In contrast, eastern parts will be cooler, cloudier and breezier. With clear skies overnight we may see some rural frost in the north.
