Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places starting overcast and misty with occasional hill fog, patchy drizzle, and sea fog along eastern coasts. Through the day warm sunny spells developing for most places, except rain will reach Northern Ireland this afternoon. The rain will clear overnight from Northern Ireland, then reaching Wales and western parts of England and Scotland. Isolated showers following to Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Saturday rain, mostly light, will clear away from eastern areas. Broken cloud and scattered, mostly light showers will follow, although through the afternoon many places will become dry and sunny. Sunday rain for Northern Scotland, otherwise dry with sunny spells.
