Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a chilly start, England and Wales will have a much drier and brighter day with plenty of sunshine and light winds. Northern Ireland, Cumbria and more especially western Scotland, will be cloudier with brisk winds and scattered light showers throughout the day, although these should become fewer and far between by late afternoon.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Scotland, Northern Ireland and parts of northwest England will be rather cloudy with some showery outbreaks of rain at times during Friday, but drier and brighter elsewhere. Saturday will be similar, but becoming windier with persistent rain spreading eastwards across all parts later in the day.
