

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 04 May 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A largely fine and dry day with plenty of long sunny spells. Heavy rain across Scotland will clear northeastwards and showers, some heavy, will linger across Northern Ireland. Cloud will thicken in southern England, with occasional rain arriving here later, especially in Devon and Cornwall. Highs of 19 degrees Celsius (66 F).

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

The rain band will slow across northern Scotland on Tuesday with sunny spells developing elsewhere. Winds will strengthen from the south with a risk of gales and some blustery showers. It will be windy with heavy, possibly thundery showers on Wednesday.
