

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain will edge northwards across central England and east Wales through today, allowing brighter conditions with scattered sharp showers to follow into southern parts. Across northern England, Scotland and Northern Ireland it will be generally drier and brighter, though still a few light showers around. Feeling unseasonably cool everywhere, especially in the rain and breeze.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
More widely drier and brighter on Monday, with a mix of sunny intervals and scattered light showers. However, rain will spread into the southwest on Monday afternoon, and then onwards to many other parts of England and Wales by Tuesday.
