Headline:

Frosty start for some. Rain in west, later in east

Today:

Many northeastern areas will dawn bright and frosty, while the south will start damp and cloudy. Rain/drizzle will reach the west by lunchtime spreading across many areas this afternoon with some hill snow over Scotland. Mild in the south.

Tonight:

Snow over highland Scotland, otherwise cloudy and wet for many.

Outlook for Saturday:

Becoming bright or sunny once rain clears east/southeast England. Wintry showers in northwest as winds increase gale force.
