Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rain over Northern England and North Wales moving south into East Anglia, the south Midlands and South Wales by dusk. To the south of the rain a good deal of cloud but with some brighter intervals. Northern Ireland will be dry with bright or sunny spells and much of Scotland will become dry as blustery showers and very strong winds become confined to the far north.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Plenty of dry though cloudy weather over England and Wales. Rain will affect Northern Ireland and Scotland during Thursday. Friday should become drier with some sunshine. Temperatures near or a little above normal.
