Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Mostly cloudy today with showers or spells of rain, some heavy.
Windy, with gales along southern and eastern coasts. Temperatures
around normal.
Heavy and locally blustery showers continuing for many overnight,
with some more persistent rain in places. Gales in the southeast,
winds easing elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Generally cloudy and showery with just occasional sunny spells on
Saturday. Some heavy and squally showers. Brightest across N.Ireland
and western Scotland. Breezy.
Sunny spells and showers, often heavy and prolonged, on Sunday. The
driest and brightest conditions are expected across western Scotland,
central and eastern England. Mostly light winds.
Temperatures around normal both days.
