

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Warm and largely fine, although much less hot than yesterday for many. It'll be cloudier too, with the risk of thundery showers; mainly across the south initially, and towards northern parts later. Cloud will gradually clear from the west this evening, with any remaining thundery showers clearing northeast Scotland early tonight. It'll be cooler than on recent nights.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A fresher start than on previous days, with sunny spells for most. It'll turn increasingly warm and humid, especially across the south, with thundery rain spreading north later. This rain will clear the north during Saturday, with drier, fresher, breezier conditions following.
